

You don't have to be a resort guest to experience the legendary courses at Kiawah Island—

Here are a few details to know to make the most of your round!

TEE TIME ACCESS

Non-resort guests can book tee times up to **60 DAYS** in advance, which gives you a fair shot at desirable slots.

GREEN FEES & COURSES

The Ocean Course, known for its dramatic views and PGA Championship history, is open to the public. Expect green fees between \$373 and \$463, depending on the season. Summer twilight rates after 2:00PM can bring that number down a bit.

In addition to *The Ocean Course*, Kiawah Island Golf Resort offers four other excellent public-access courses:

Cougar Point, Turtle Point, Osprey Point, & Oak Point.

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU PLAY

CADDIE SERVICES:

Available at all courses. While not required, tipping is customary—around \$120 for a walking caddie or \$60 for a forecaddie.

WALKING POLICY:

You can walk all courses. *The Ocean Course* is walking-only from September through May. From June through August, carts are allowed after 10:00AM.

PRACTICE FACILITIES:

Each course has a full driving range and putting green. If you've booked a tee time, range balls are complimentary. If not, practice access is available for \$30 PER HOUR.
