- 1. PHILEDELPHIA ALLEY**, one of the oldest cobblestone streets in Charleston.
 - The **PINEAPPLE FOUNTAIN** is an iconic landmark in Charleston.
1 Vendue Range
 - The **CHARLESTON CITY MARKET**, established in 1790, is full of local vendors.
188 Meeting Street
 - Take a glimpse of America's first theatre, **DOCK STREET THEATRE!**
135 Church Street
 - Take a walk down this iconic row of colorful homes at **RAINBOW ROW**.
83 East Bay Street
 - Explore lush gardens and narrow alleyways at **LONGITUDE LANE** and **STOLL'S ALLEY**.
 - Enjoy views of the harbor and historic homes at **WHITE POINT GARDEN**.
2 Murray Boulevard
 - The corner of Meeting and Broad Streets includes City Hall, St. Michaels, federal and county courthouse and is called the **FOUR CORNERS OF LAW**
71 Broad Street
 - UNITARIAN CHURCH & CEMENTARY**, the second oldest church in Charleston!
